The AGENDA for each Parish Council Meeting will be posted on the Notice Board next to the Village Hall, and on the Parish website not less than three working days before the Meeting.

The ANNUAL PARISH MEETING is open to All Registered Electors within Great Glemham Parish and is held in May each year. The agenda for this will be posted not less than seven working days before the meeting. This meeting is an opportunity for all parishioners to express their views.
